

FINAL NOTICE
THE DEADLINE TO RETURN YOUR CENSUS IS
SUNDAY, APRIL 15, 2018

(Due to the fact that April 15th is a Sunday and April 16th is a holiday you will have until Tuesday April 17th to return them to the Town Clerk's Office.)

Massachusetts General Law Chapter 51, Section 4
requires all Towns to send out an annual census.

In any city or town which communicates with residents by mail for the purpose of obtaining such information, the communication shall state in boldface type on the postcard, envelope and printed material contained in such communication the following statement: **"warning - failure to respond to this mailing for 2 consecutive years shall result in removal from the active voting list and may result in removal from the voter registration rolls."**

If you are a registered voter and you do not return your census for two consecutive years we are required to make your voting status inactive. This means that you will not be allowed to vote in an election until you provide evidence that you are a West Bridgewater resident. After failing to respond to the census for four consecutive years, you will be removed from the voter list altogether and you will not be able to vote, unless you re-register.

Massachusetts General Law Chapter 51 Section 6
requires all Towns prepare an annual street list.

The registrars on or before April fifteenth in each year, shall prepare lists containing the names and addresses of all persons seventeen years of age or older listed by them under Section Four (see above) for the current year.

If you need a census form, you can stop by the Town Clerk's Office or contact the office at 508-894-1200 X7100. We are open Wednesday's 8am to 7pm for those of you who cannot visit the Town Hall during regular business hours. There is also a payment box on the front steps of the Town Hall, you can place your census in that as well.
